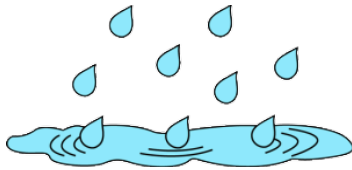

Children's Ministry

The **PUDDLE** is our nursery class for ages birth through 3 years old. Our teachers love to love on our babies! We offer nursery class during Sunday mornings at 9:00am where the babies hear an age-appropriate Bible story, and again at 10:15am during the morning worship service. We also offer nursery class on Wednesday evenings from 6:30-7:30pm.



The **POND** is our preschool class for ages 3 (potty trained) through Kindergarten. In The Pond, we learn about the Bible through lessons and crafts. We have loads of fun and are always enriching our Pre-K class. Come and learn & love with us every Wednesday at 6:30pm and Sundays at 9:00am and 10:15am.

The **HCN Kids Cove** is for our elementary age children. We strive to teach children of all ages to know Christ, love others and to make disciples of Jesus. On Sunday mornings, our Sunday School class begins at 9:00am. Following class, the children attend Children's Church at 10:15am which begins with worship in the sanctuary with the adults. On Wednesday evenings, we have children's Caravan classes from 6:30pm-7:30pm. Caravans is a kids' program committed to the physical, social, mental, and spiritual growth of children. It uses an active, hands-on leaning approach to help kids discover, develop, experience and grow.

Throughout the year, we offer Vacation Bible School, Children's Fun Days, Fall Festival, Christmas Programs, and Easter Egg Hunts. We also participate in Nazarene District activities that include Summer Camp, Children's Quizzing, Lock-Ins, and other activities.

All children's department workers are NazSafe trained and certified.
